Preparing an exam for use with Respondus Monitor in your LMS

Respondus Monitor builds upon the LockDown Browser technology by using a webcam to record students during an exam. Suspicious behavior is automatically flagged, such as leaving the computer during the exam, or a different person entering the video frame.



Using the "Show Your Work" Feature in Respondus Monitor

Learn how to enable the Show Your Work feature, that requires students to submit webcam photos of written work or notes at the end of an exam.
